Fermata Camps (Ts & Cs)

- All the **Fermata Camps** are held at the **Fermata School of Music**, Unit 14, Millbank Business Pk, Lucan, Co. Dublin, K78 AC. Please use GOOGLE MAPS for directions. There is FREE parking outside of school.
- Fermata Summer Camps are medium-sized group classes/activities for children aged 4 to 15. Our facilities are specially adapted to accommodate music lessons and crafts. We utilise various interactive tools and resources to make the classes enjoyable, including crafts production, boom whackers, diatonic bells, cymbals, bean bags, and more.
- The Fermata Summer Camps aim to develop an understanding of lead instruments such as piano, guitar, and violin, as well as music theory and crafts during the four or five days of Camp.
- Fermata Camps will have the following group limits:
 - o Fermata Music Camp (1-5 July): Max 18 pupils (3 groups of 6)
 - o Fermata Craft & Art Camp (1-4 July): Max 8 pupils
 - o Fermata Little Music Roots Camp (8-11 July): Max 8 pupils
 - o Fermata Guitar Camp: (8-11 July): Max 6 pupils
- Each student joining the Fermata Camps will receive a free Handouts and Fermata Folder at the beginning of the program. We recommend a moderate commitment from students each day of the Summer Camp, starting with a 10-minute daily routine to achieve satisfactory course outcomes.
- A mini-recital, included as part of your summer camp experience, will take place on the last day of the selected camp. Students and parents will have full access to the exclusive Student/Parent portal, which is available for solo or partner lessons. Each course concludes with a small graduation ceremony and free Fermata Certificates.
- You will have full access to the Student/Parent portal, exclusive to SOLO or PARTNER LESSONS & Music Club students.
- The Fermata Summer Camps consist of four or five consecutive daily sessions, each with an individual schedule based on the complexity of the activities. Any outstanding balance (deposit + fees) will be refunded if we cancel a Summer Camp. Please note that each camp requires a minimum number of students to launch.
- If your child misses a day of Summer Camp, please be aware that our camps are highly structured, and we only accept bookings for the full duration of the camp. We do not offer reimbursement for absences or negligence.
- A full payment for the Summer Camp is required 7 days before the start date. Cheques should be made payable to Fermata Music School. We also accept cash, EFT, or Revolut payments. **Booking deposits** must be paid within 3-5 working days from booking to confirm your place in the camp.
- The Music Camp aims to understand some of the school's lead instruments (piano, violin, guitar, bass, ukulele, singing) during the 4 or 5 days at the **Fermata Camp**.
- Students deemed disruptive to other students, teachers, or staff members will be asked to leave, or their guardians will be asked to collect them. We aim to have a **FUN** and **PROFESSIONAL** atmosphere in the **Summer Camps**.

- Photo/Video Release you agree to the Fermata Photo/Video Release policy by enrolling your child in Fermata Summer Camps. This allows the Fermata School of Music to capture and use photographs and videos taken during the Summer Camps for promotional and educational purposes. Please contact our office to discuss alternative arrangements if you have any concerns or objections regarding using your child's image.
- The **Fermata Camps** are lead by Fermata School of Music educators, often with decades of experience; we adhere to Child Protection Policy.
- **The Security Deposit (€50)** should be paid no later than 5 working days after Fermata Music School calls with a place offer in the chosen Fermata Camp.
- BALANCE of a PAYMENT FOR CHOSEN FERMATA CAMP must be settled no later than seven days before the 1st day. Failing to make a payment will result in losing a place.
